FIRST NATIONS HEALTH BENEFITS (PLAN W) OTC COVERAGE

- The First Nations Health Authority's (FNHA) Plan W (Wellness) is a publicly funded health benefits program available for individuals registered under the Indian Act living in British Columbia. Eligible individuals can contact FNHA to enroll.
- It provides coverage for eligible medical supplies, devices and equipment, and over-the-counter (OTC) products when prescribed by a doctor or recommended by a pharmacist.*
- Search the FNHA Drug Benefit List (QR code/link on top left corner) to see if a product is eligible for coverage.
